


1 of 5 Parking areas on Ridgeway = 2 bags







B4192 RHS to Commonhead Tight scrub, broken trees, no access to 2 public paths




B4192 RHS to Commonhead

B4192 LHS to Commonhead Buckled fencing along the whole route








Liddington won "Best Small Village" in 2004. It wouldn't get it now!

SUMMARY B4192 Commonhead to Ridgeway x-roads

- Death & Injury imminent to walkers and cyclists
- The Village is cut off from Coate and the Hospital (both of which are in the Liddington parish)
- Also, from national busses and Swindon cycle paths
- On both sides of the village, this road is disgusting
- Speed limit is 60mph much too fast

OBJECTIVE 1 Village to Commonhead

RHS:

- Footpath, wear out the grass
- Seasonal plants roadside

· LHS:

- Remove fencing
- Cut back the vegetation

Fixtures:

- 40mph signs
- Move "Welcome" move to Commonhead
- "Take your Rubbish Home"

WHY?:

- Access Swindon pathway
- Save on death/injury
- Reduce litter
- Beautify access
- Be proud of our village



OBJECTIVE 2 Village to Ridgeway X-Roads

RHS:

- Bordered with seasonal plants roadside
- Remove broken fencing
- Rebuild the Permissive Right of Way
- Extend it beyond the X-Roads to Liddington Hill

• LHS:

Bordered with seasonal plants

Fixtures:

- 40mph signs
- 30mph moved east 200m
- Move "Welcome" to X-Roads
- "Please do not Litter" signs
